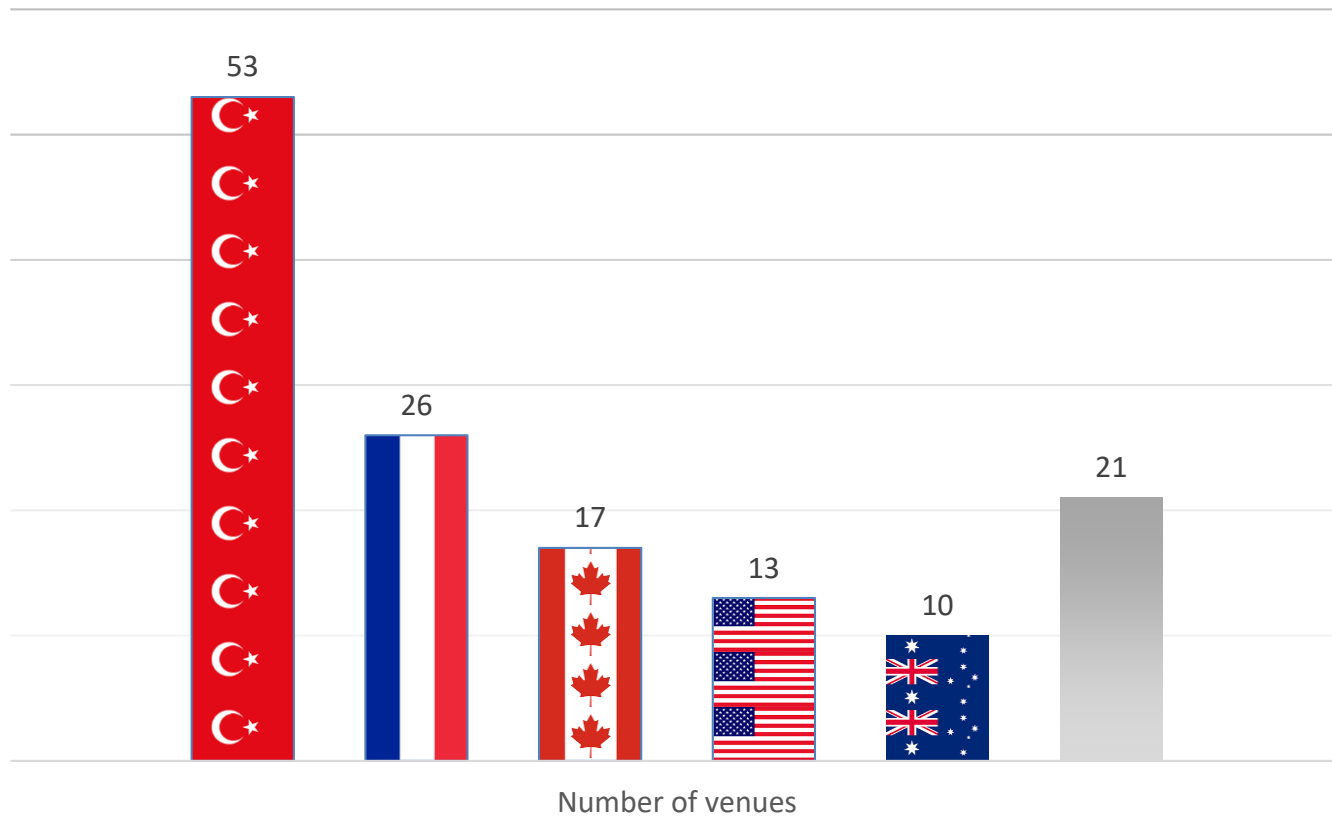
# Venues Map

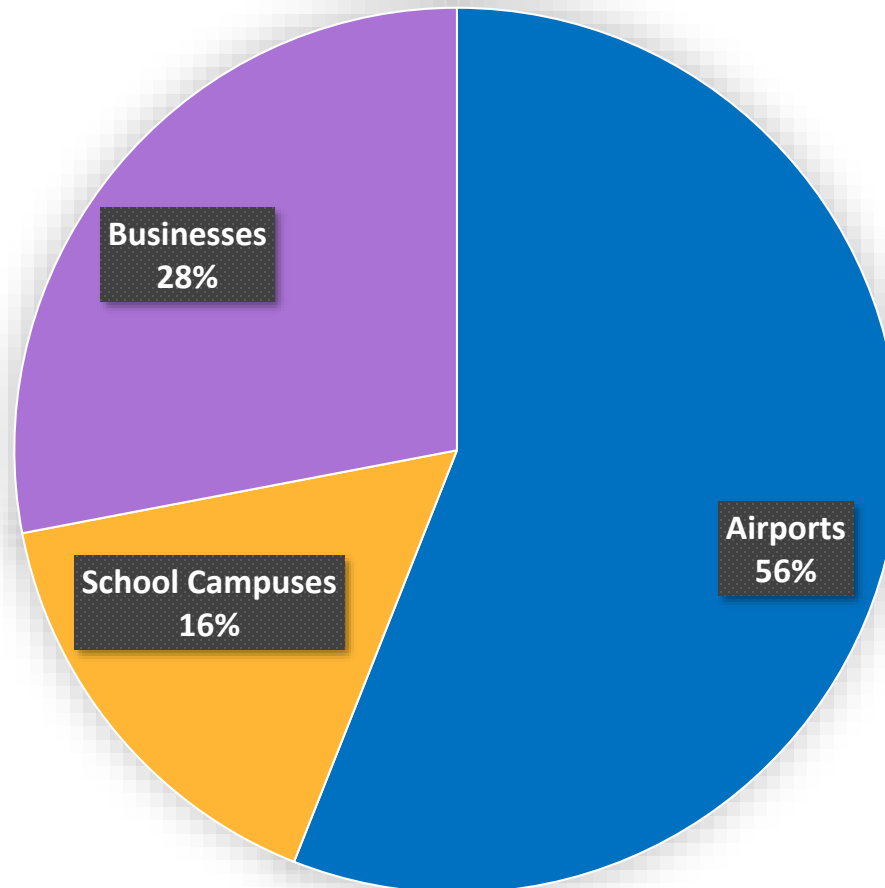

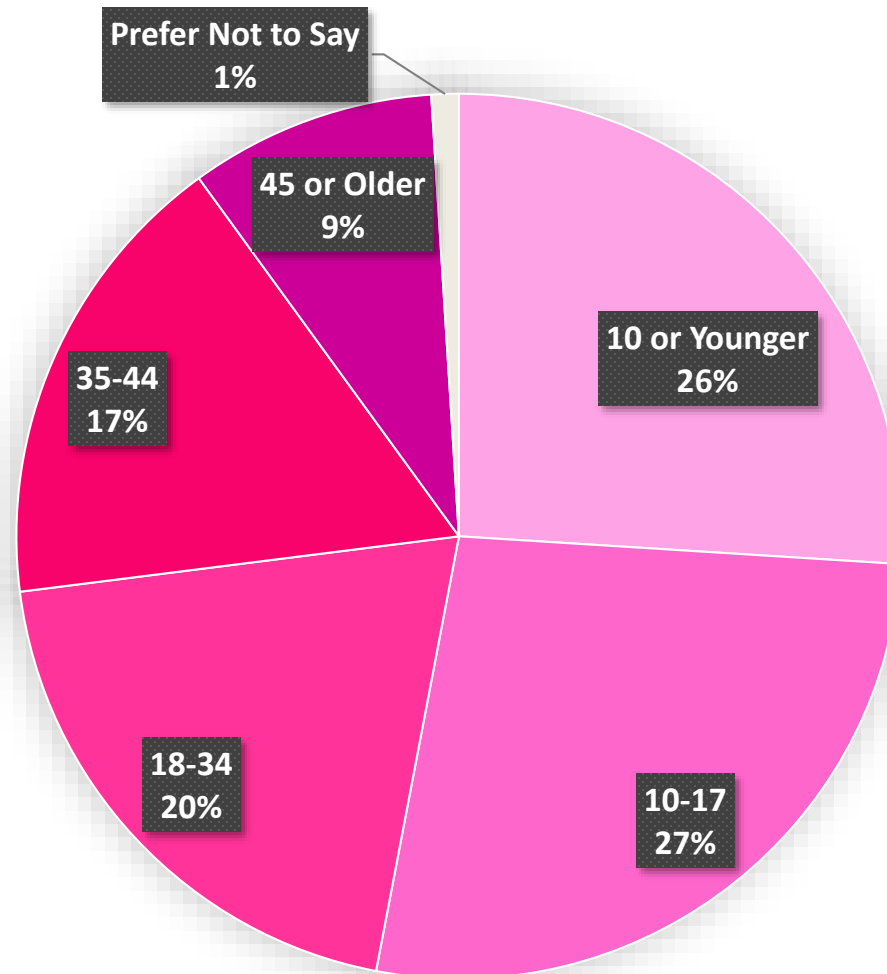

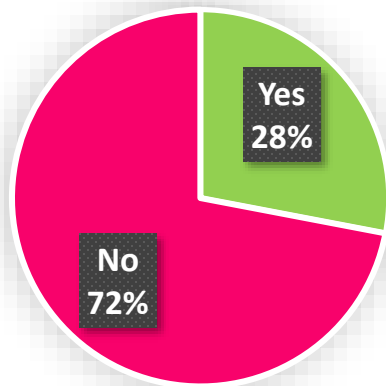

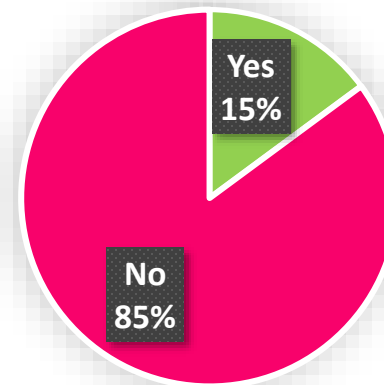

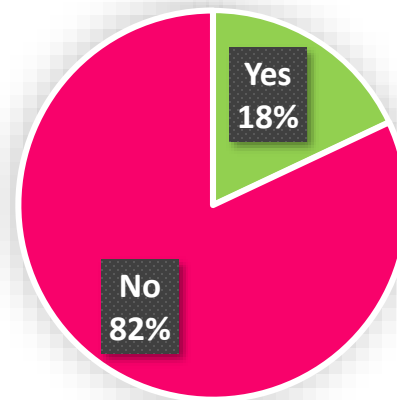
