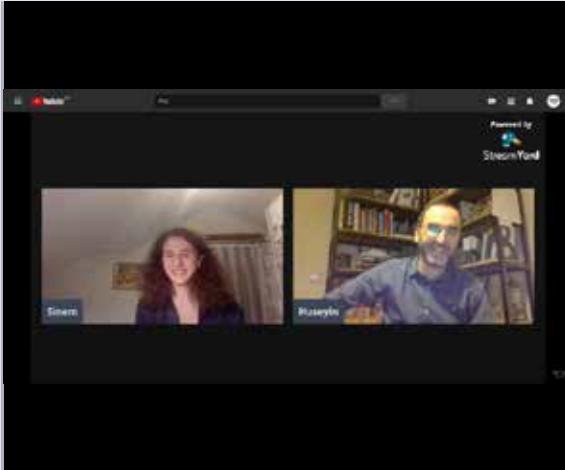
Air Conversations
